**Significant Updates**

- Effective April 1, 2020, welfare and morale checks will be conducted telephonically to all Park Vista residents.
- The Joint Information Center is fully staffed and stationed at the El Segundo Library. For further information or to contact the JIC, call 310-692-1699.
- The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health has revised the manner in which information regarding confirmed cases by city is released. Prior, LADPH reported El Segundo had two confirmed cases. Now, LADPH will not report the numbers of a city with a population below 25,000, such as El Segundo, unless they have five or more confirmed cases.

**Closures and Orders**

- All Los Angeles County beaches, beach parking lots, beach related facilities including restrooms, bike paths and hiking trails are closed.
- The El Segundo Police Department lobby closed. If you need non-emergency services, call 310-524-2200 in advance to set-up an available appointment.
- All El Segundo parks, fields, sports courts, exercise equipment, and other recreation facilities including the Lakes Golf Course are closed. Individuals may still walk or jog through the parks, provided they maintain a social distance of six feet.
- The Los Angeles County Health Officer issued the “Safer at Home Order for Control of COVID-19” which applies to most Los Angeles County cities including El Segundo. Governor Newsom also issued Executive Order N-33-20, which orders all individuals living in the State of California to stay at home or at their place of residence.

**Current El Segundo Objectives**

Provide for health and safety of public, first responders and city employees.
Provide emergency response services and essential city services within the COVID-19 precautions and guidelines.
Provide the community with current and accurate information through the Public Information Officer, Joint Information Center, and Liaison Officer.
Ensure fiscal responsibility through established municipal guidelines and the completion of documentation for cost recovery under public assistance.

**Current Initiatives**

Provide a comprehensive COVID-19 exposure prevention plan, including personal hygiene, hand washing, keeping hands away from face, and maintaining social distancing.
If you are sick, stay at home and inform your supervisor of your status.
All supervisors assigned to the incident are responsible to provide adequate incident safety briefs and COVID-19 precautions to all employees assigned for supervision. This includes pre-assignment briefings at the beginning of each operational period.
All first responders should follow Personal Protective Equipment and patient care practices as set forth by the Medical Unit Leader and Safety Officer. Information included in the Incident Action Plan.
Be polite, professional, and demonstrate care and compassion to reduce unnecessary fear and anxiety in the community.
Maintain situational awareness on impacts of COVID-19 to the City of El Segundo, Dockweiler RV Park, and the County of Los Angeles.
Keep the community informed, including at risk community members, through the Outreach Group, Public Information Officer, and Liaison Officer.
Provide the required effort and resources to meet the needs within Park Vista.

**External Operations Impacting El Segundo**

<b>Dockweiler RV Park:</b> LA County OEM/LA County Dept of Health is utilizing Dockweiler RV Park as an isolation zone for people who have COVID-19 and have no place to self-isolate. There are 110 Recreational Vehicles stationed in the park to be used for those who need to be isolated. El Segundo residents should avoid this area entirely and not go north of 12505 Vista Del Mar (the Youth Center and Beach Café). As of 3/31/20 at 1430 hours, there are 27 individuals being isolated in the RV Park.
