Heart Flowers



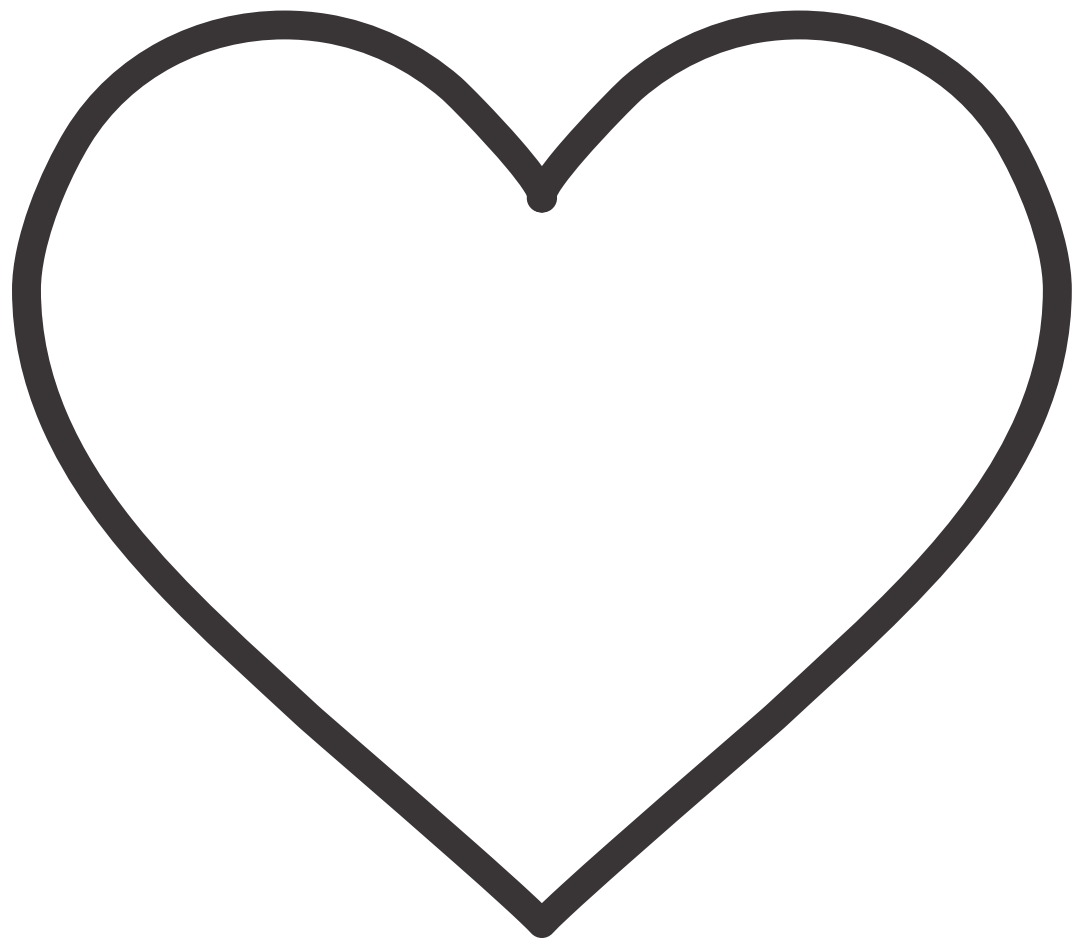
Materials

- Flower template
- Craft sticks, straw, chop stick, etc.
- Pompom, buttons, stickers, or gems
- Glue
- Scissors

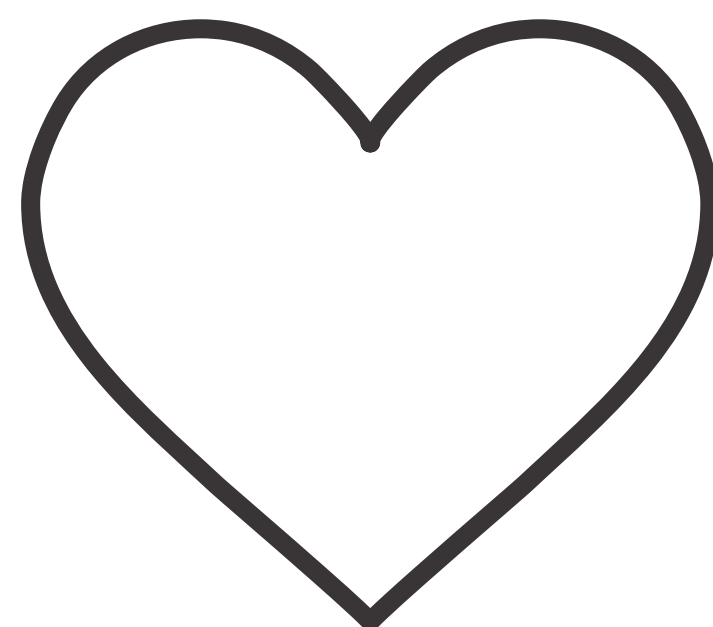
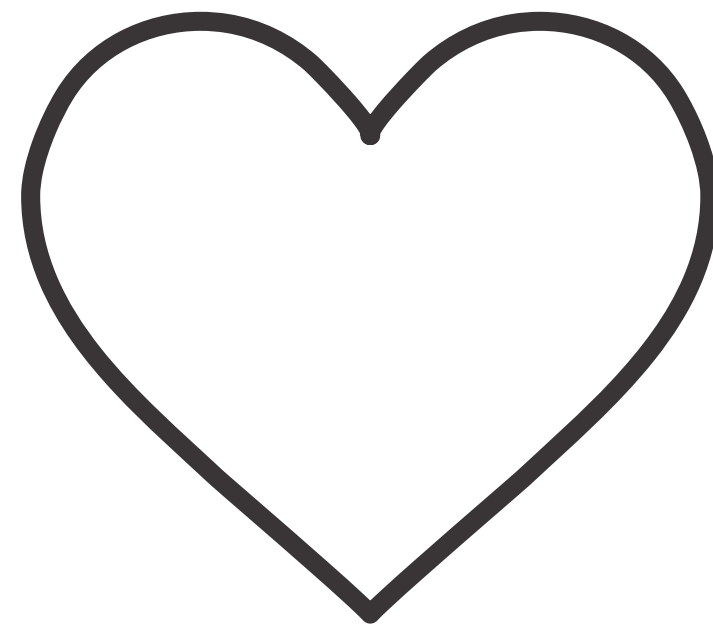
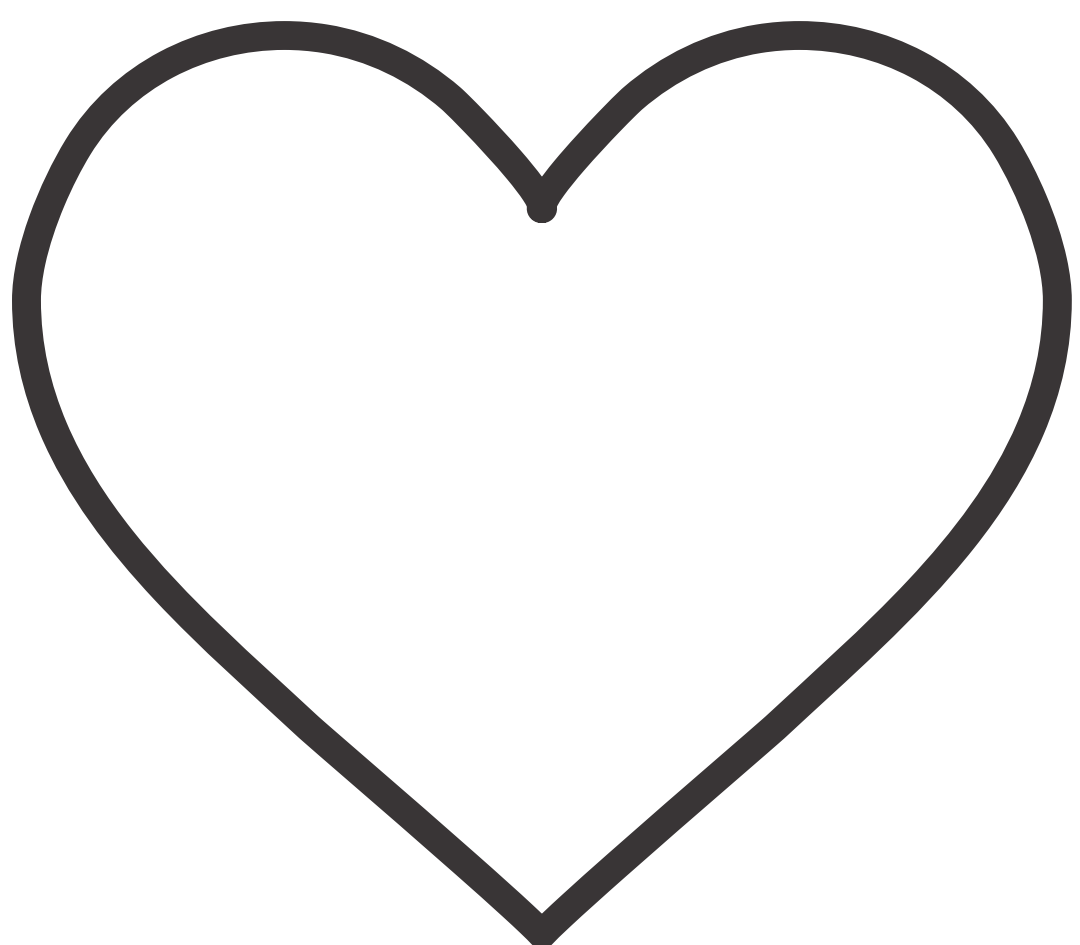
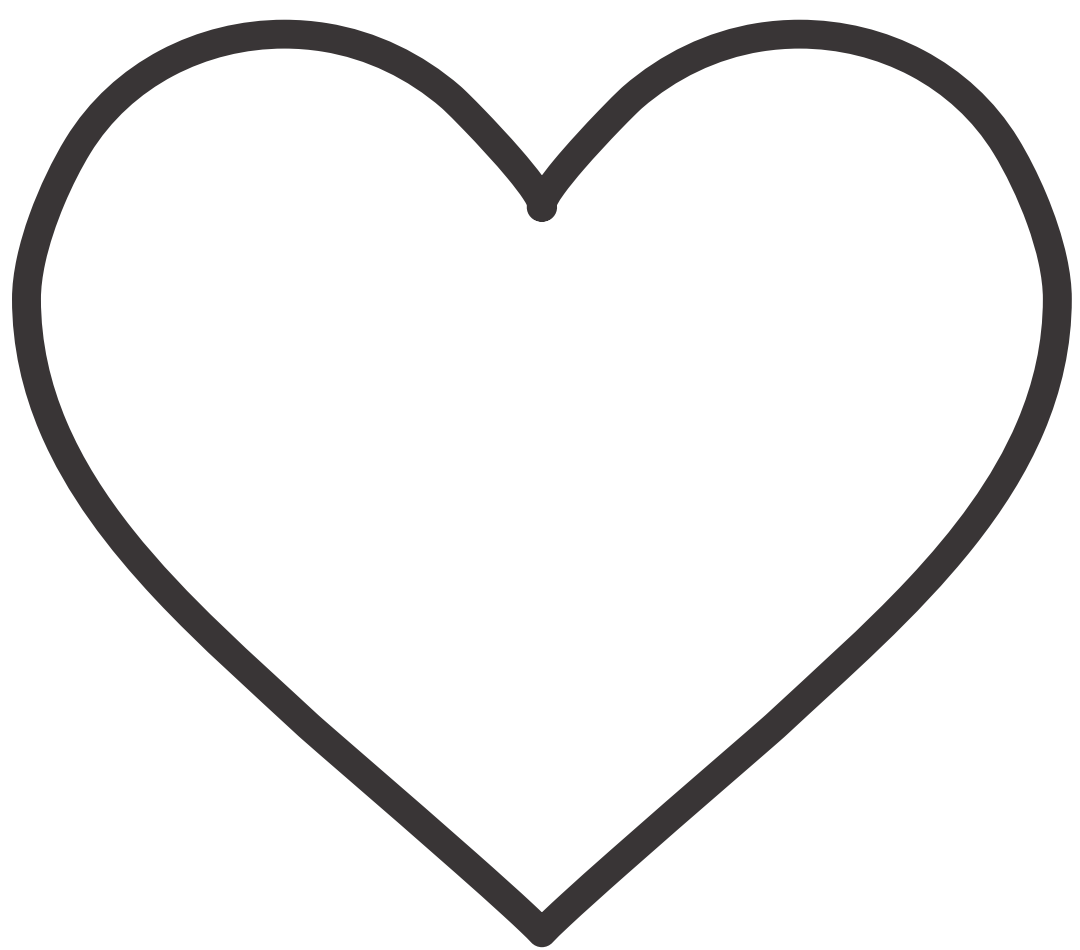
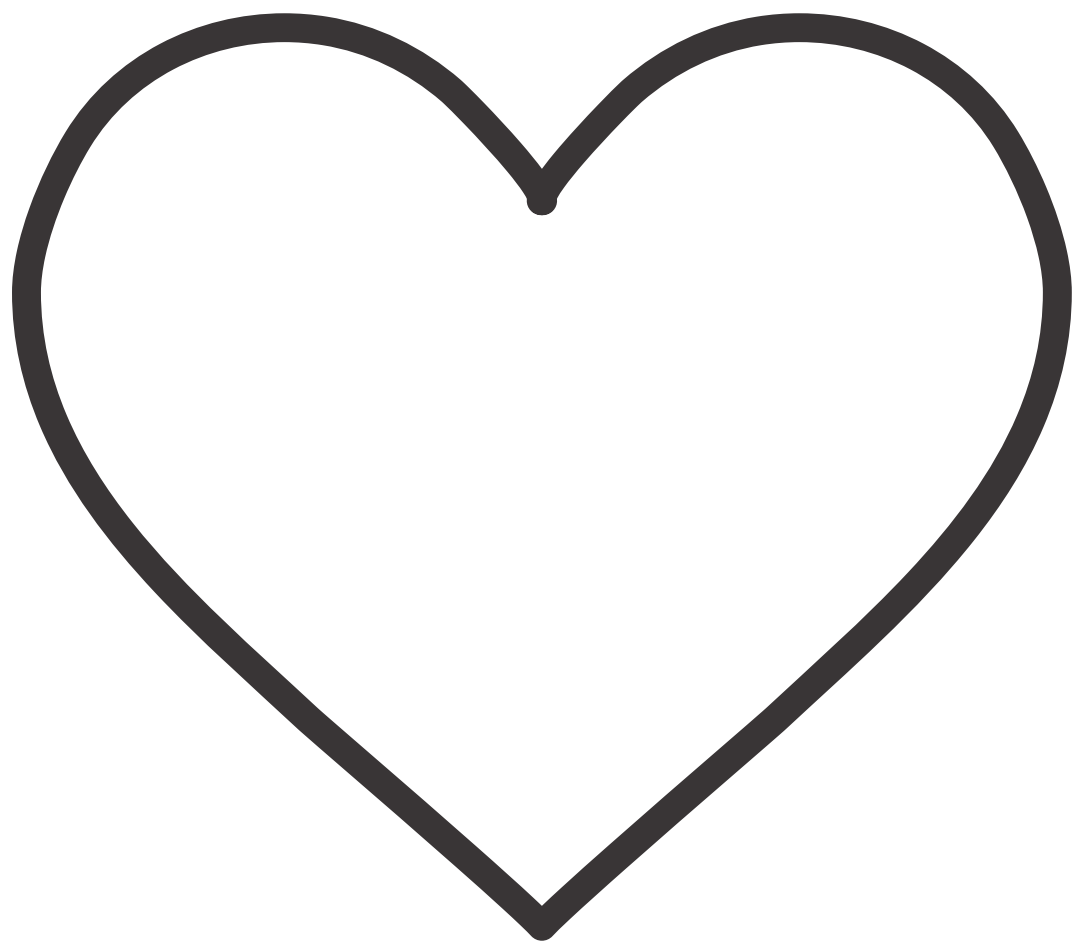
Instructions:

1. Cut out 4 hearts from your template.
2. Glue them onto whatever material you are using for your stem.
3. Optional: you can use the smaller hearts as leaves and glue them to your stem.





Cut out 4 larger hearts for the flower petals and the 2 smaller hearts for the leaves. Color them if you would like to add a little color!

Paper Lilacs

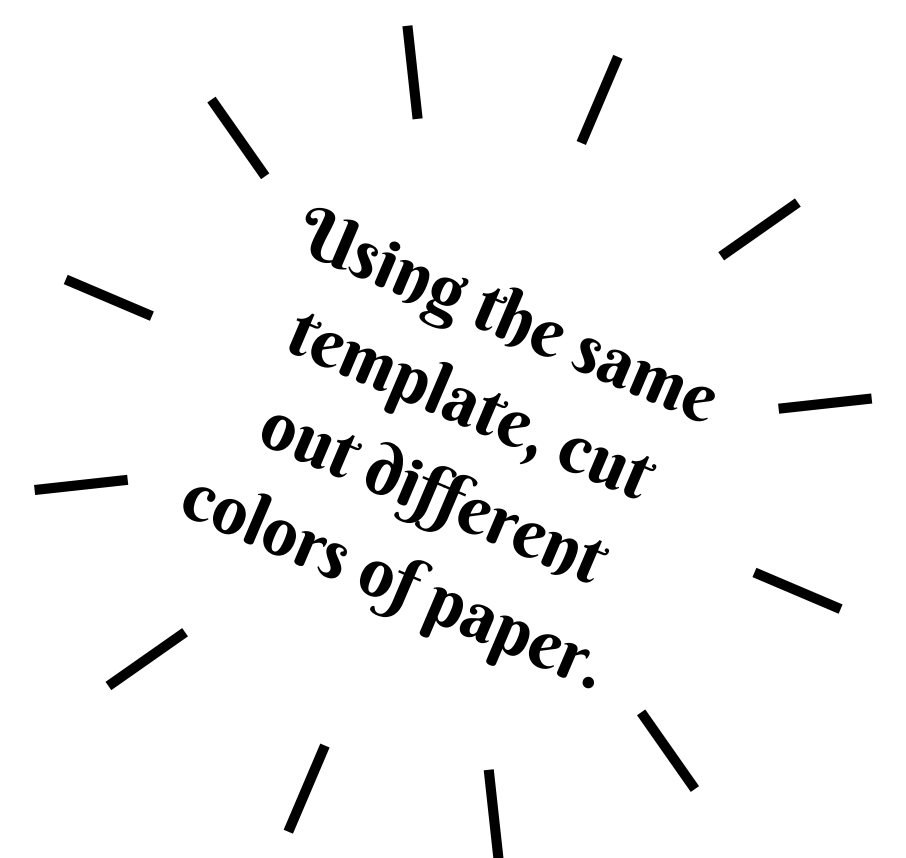


Materials

- Flower template
- Paper straw, chop stick, wooden skewer, etc.
- Glue
- Scissors

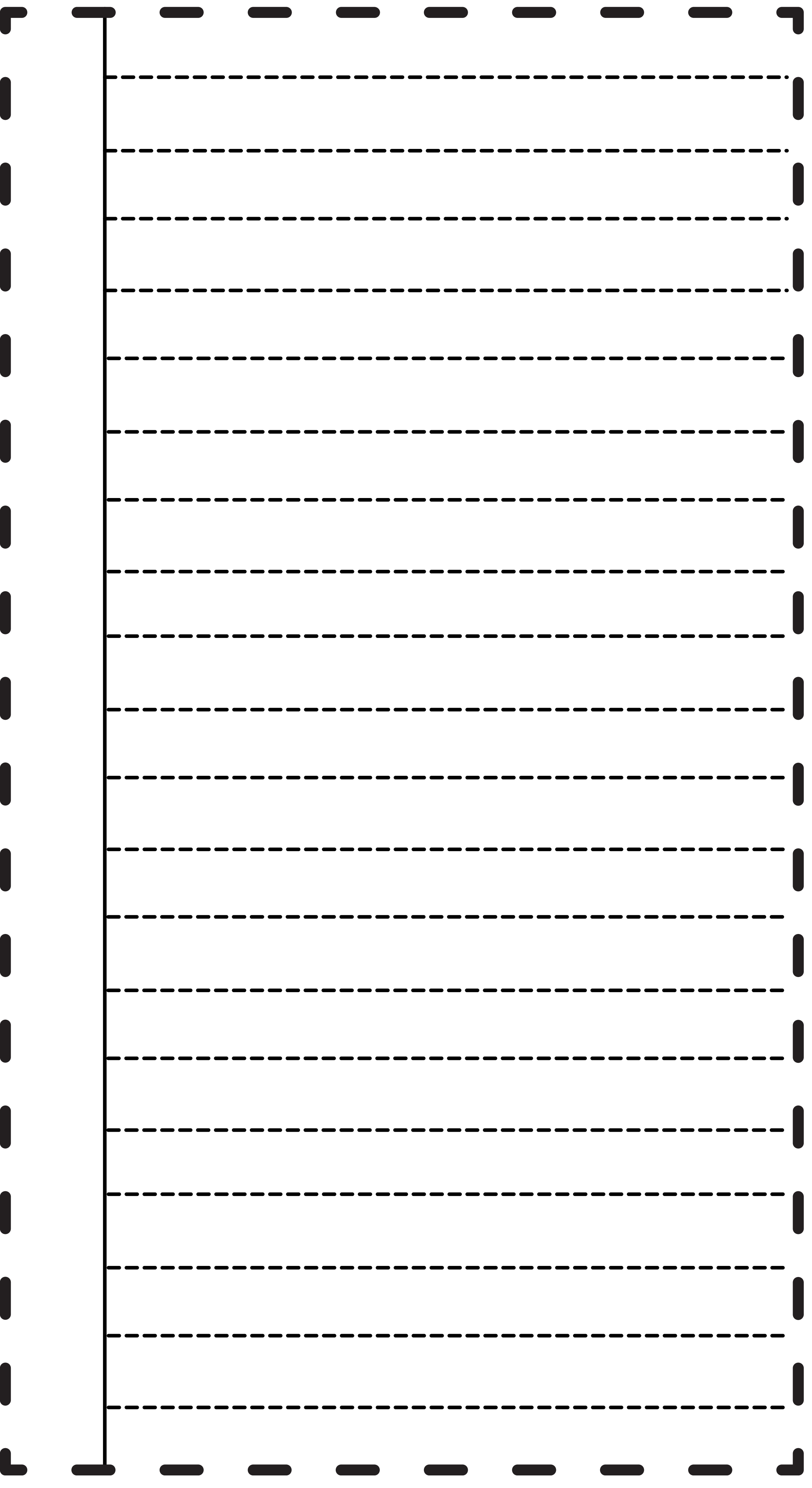
Instructions:

1. Using your lilac flower template, cut out the rectangle.
2. Now make a crease on the solid line.
3. Cut the smaller dotted line in the middle of the rectangle to make strips. Do not cut all the way through, just to the solid line.
4. Curl the strips of paper by rolling them up with a wooden stick, paper straw, pencil, etc.
5. Place a little glue on the end of the fold and wrap around your stem with the curls facing outward.
6. Secure with glue when you get to the end.



Paper Lilac Template

Cut out the rectangle and fold on the solid line. Then cut the dotted lines within the rectangle to the fold. Curl the strips using a pencil.

Paper Daisy



Materials

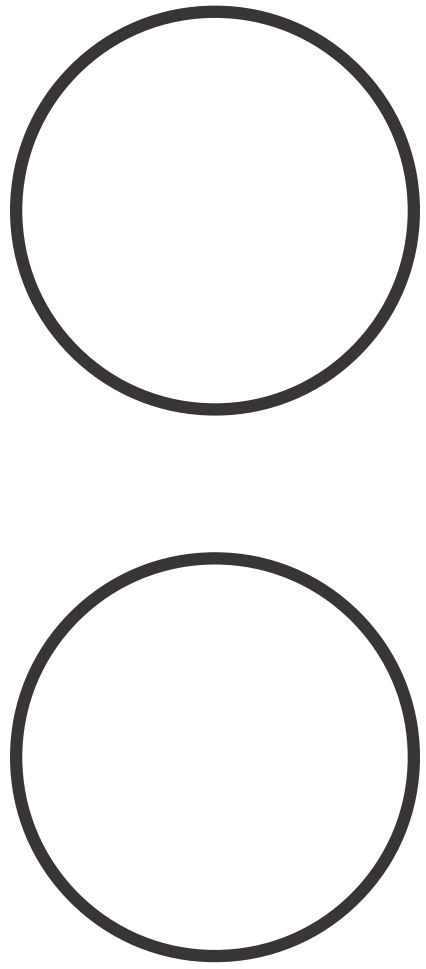
- Flower template
- Craft sticks, straw, chop stick, etc.
- Pompom, buttons, stickers, or gems
- Glue
- Scissors

Instructions

1. Cut out 8 strips from your paper daisy template.
2. Assemble your strips of paper to look like a star burst, securing them with a dab of glue in the center.
3. Place some glue in the center of your star burst and fold the outer tips into the center.
4. Glue the flower center using any material you would like. (For example pompoms, buttons, stickers, gems, or paper circle.)
5. Glue the flower to a stem, using whatever material you would like. (For example paper straws, chop sticks, craft sticks, etc.)
6. Optional: the template has leaves if you would like to use them on your flower.

Paper Daisy Template

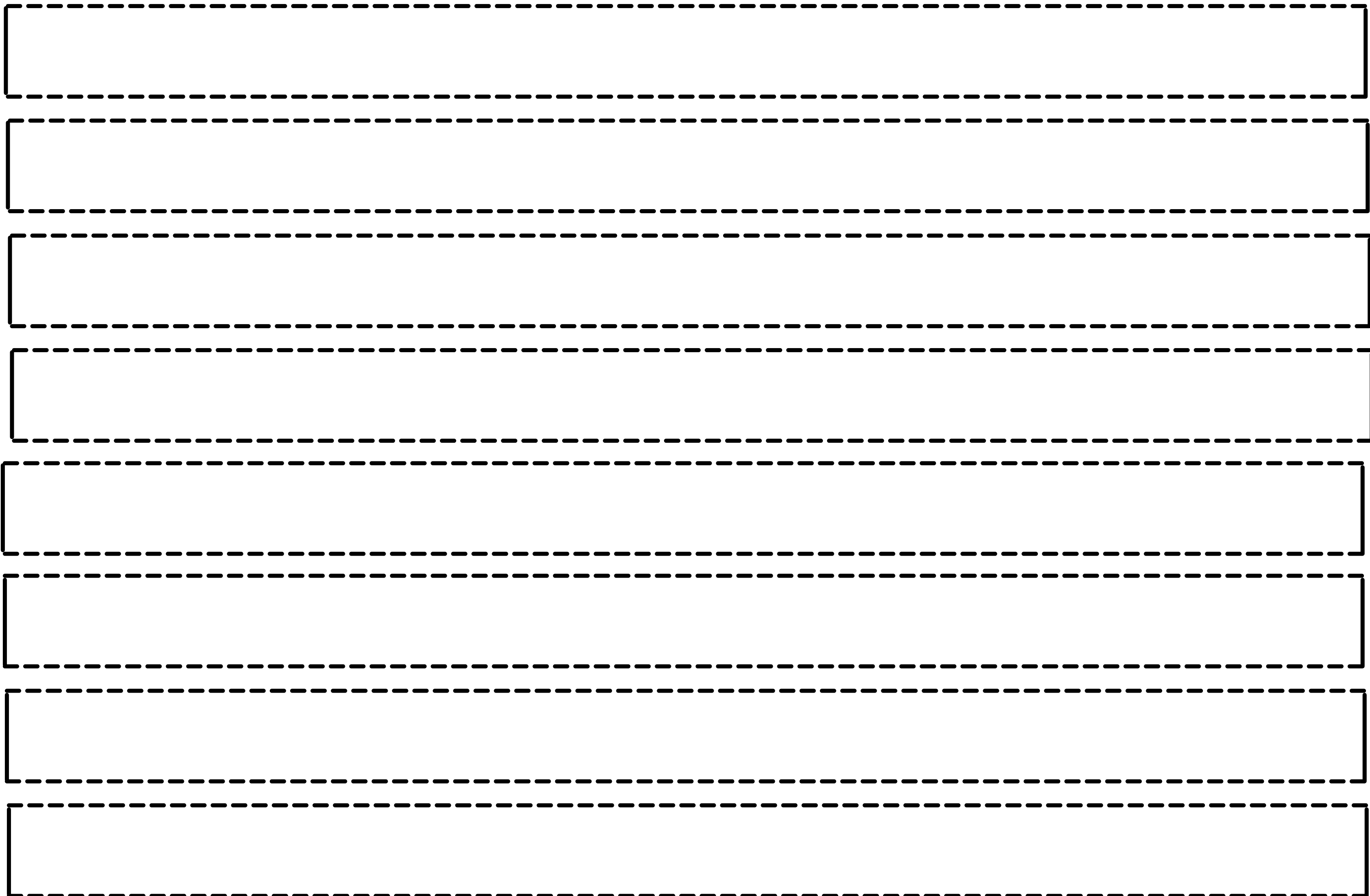
Color and cut out for your flower center.

Color and cut out. These will be your flower petals.

Cut and Curl Roses

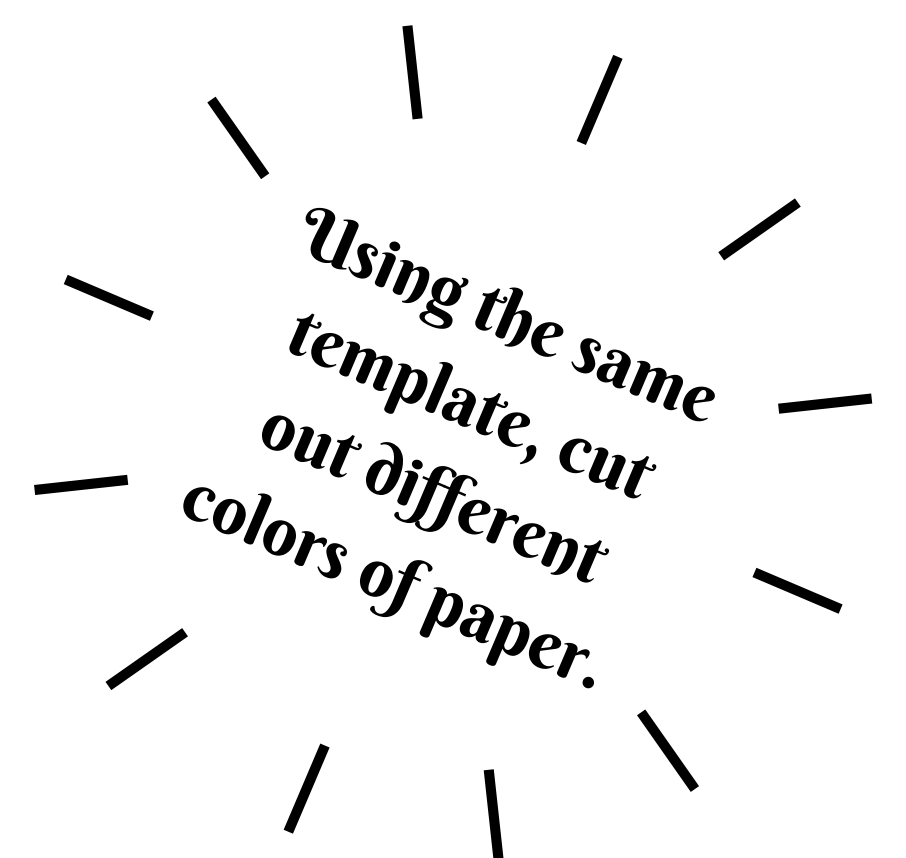


Materials

- Paper print out
- Paper straw, chop sticks or craft sticks
- Glue
- Scissors
- Pencil

Instructions

1. Using the print out to start, cut out the circle/spiral rose template.
2. Cut the inner spiral as well.
3. Start rolling your paper spiral until you get the "x".
4. Place glue on the "x", and glue down your spiraled paper. This forms your rose. If some of it becomes unraveled, it's okay. It will make your rose more fuller looking.
5. Glue onto a stem if you wish.



Using the same template, cut out different colors of paper.
