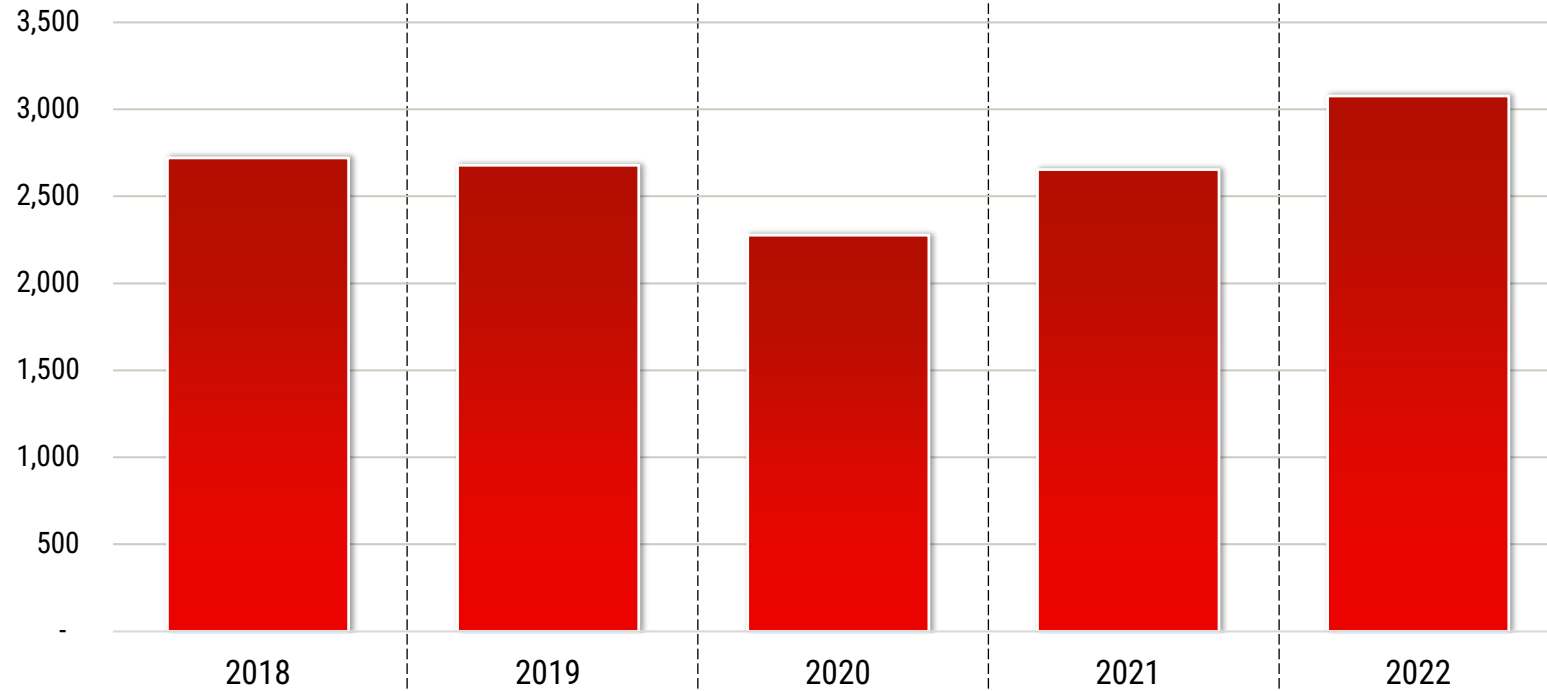

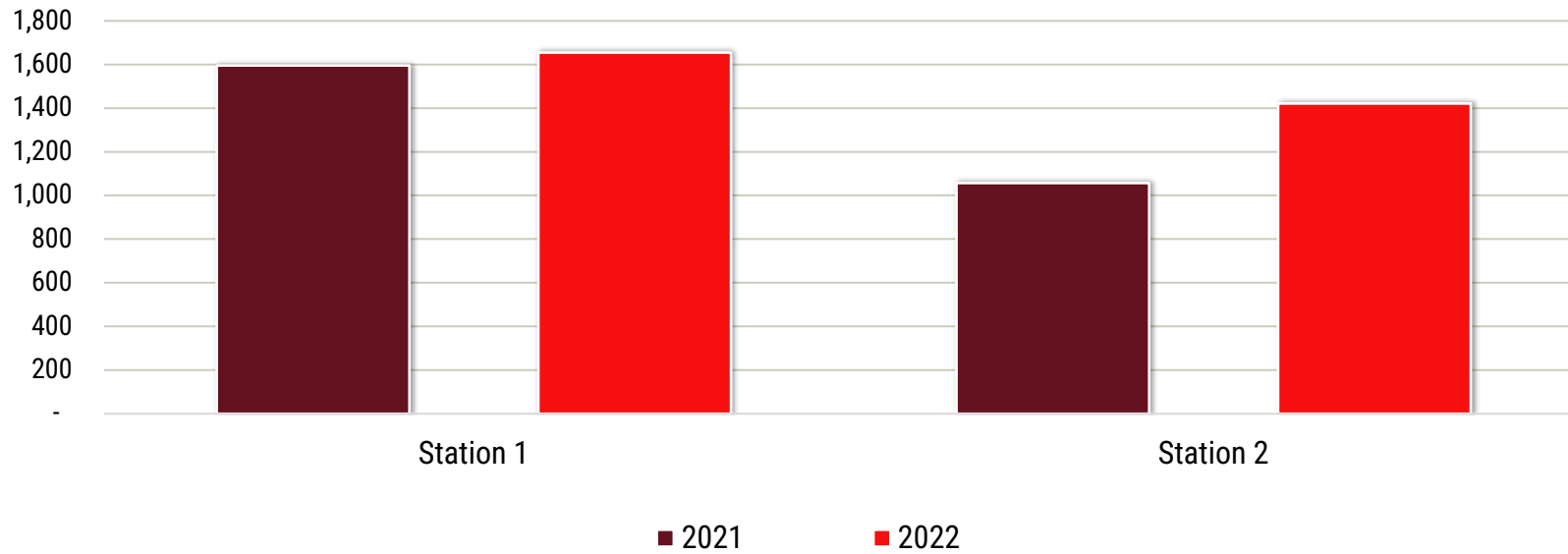

2021-2022

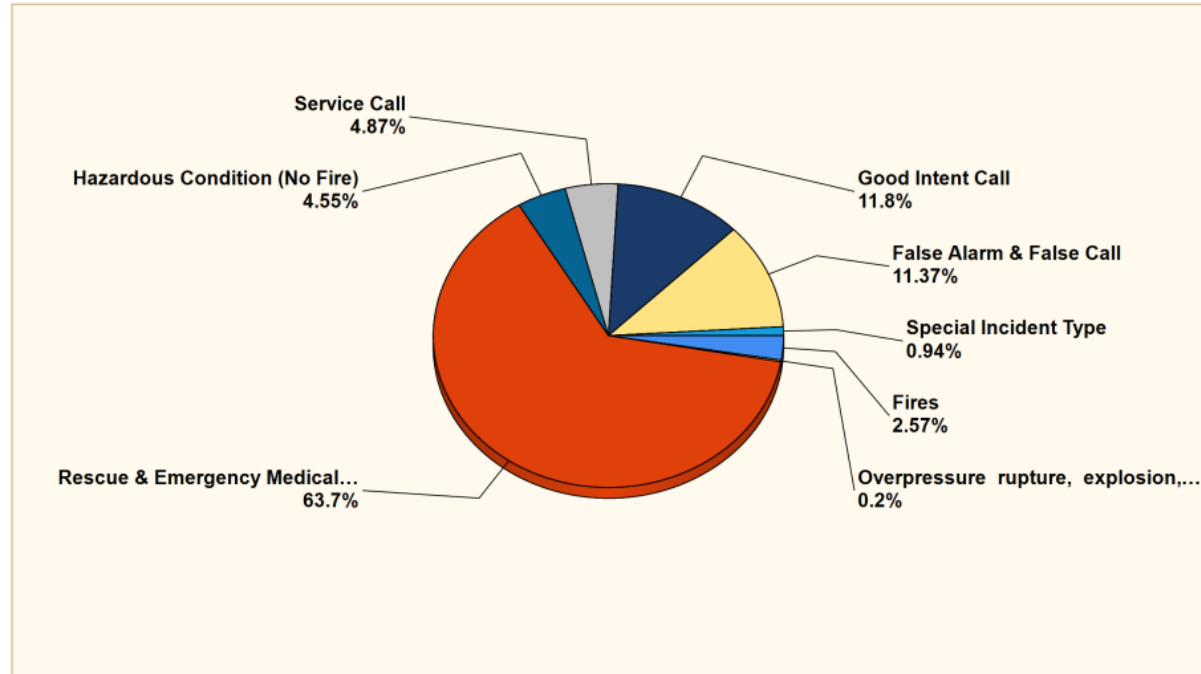

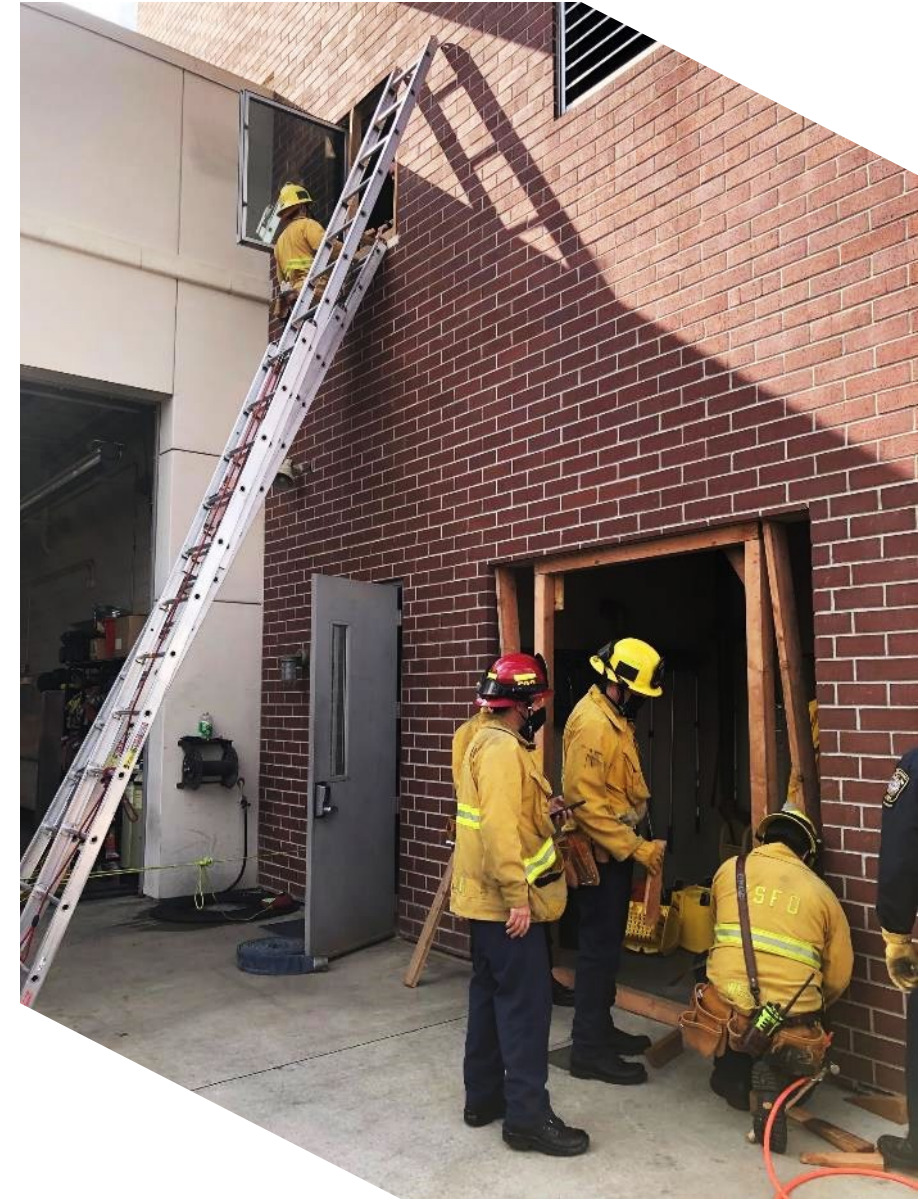
